

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary greatly).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)

£2476.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements

£1050.00

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care

£190.00

Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities.

The deceased person will be kept at funeral director's branch premises

£275.00

Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from a quality soft wood veneer construction

£355.00

Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)

At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)

Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)²

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.¹

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:

£734.00 – £1100.00

For a new grave, you may need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**.²

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

TERMS OF BUSINESS

Our estimates are an indication of the charges likely to be incurred on the basis of the information and details we know at the date of estimate. The charges are liable to alteration particularly where third parties change their rates or charges.

We may not know the amount of third-party charges in advance of the funeral, however we will give you a best estimate of such charges on the w The actual amount of the charges will be detailed and shown in the final account.

Payment arrangements

The funeral account is due for payment within 30 days of our account, unless otherwise agreed with us. If you fail to pay us in full on the due date

- at a rate of 4.5% above our bank's base rate
- calculated (on a daily basis) from the date of our account until payment;
- before and after any judgement (unless a court orders otherwise).

Deposit - A deposit for the disbursement element of the funeral is required 2 working days prior to the funeral date but is discretionary in certain for the payment.

Simple and Direct Cremation services full payment is required prior to the funeral taking place.
